Covid 19 Directive July 19th 2021
(reprint/update of October 1 2020 Directive)

As you are aware the Province has now moved to Stage 3 of "The Road to Reopening" and under those directives the Parry Sound Anglers and Hunters will proceed with the reopening of Ranges and Facilities under the following restrictions.

I want to remind and emphasize to all Members that we have a responsibility for the safety of each other by ensuring the highest level of hygienic care while at our facility.

Each Member is responsible for their own health and safety.

In addition, the following are specific instructions for use of the ranges and facilities.

1. All members must complete a Covid 19 self diagnosis evaluation prior to entering ranges and or facilities, these are posted at all entrances.
2. All members must wear appropriate face covering, practice social distancing and hand washing/sanitizing.
3. The current capacity for the club house is 25, all covid protocols must be followed.
4. The current capacity for the pistol club is 10, all covid protocols must be followed.
5. You must supply your own sanitizing equipment, including hand sanitizer and wipe down disinfectant. Bring your own pen to sign in.
6. Washrooms are available please wipe them down after usage
7. Shooting stations must be cleaned before and after use. Pick up your shells.
8. Do not not occupy a shooting station for more than one hour if someone is waiting.
9. All current rules and regulations must be strictly followed.
10. Do not be shy, if you see other Members not following the rules remind them this is still a serious matter and we are not out of it yet.

While things are looking up, we are still in a pandemic and must, by law, follow these regulations. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns
